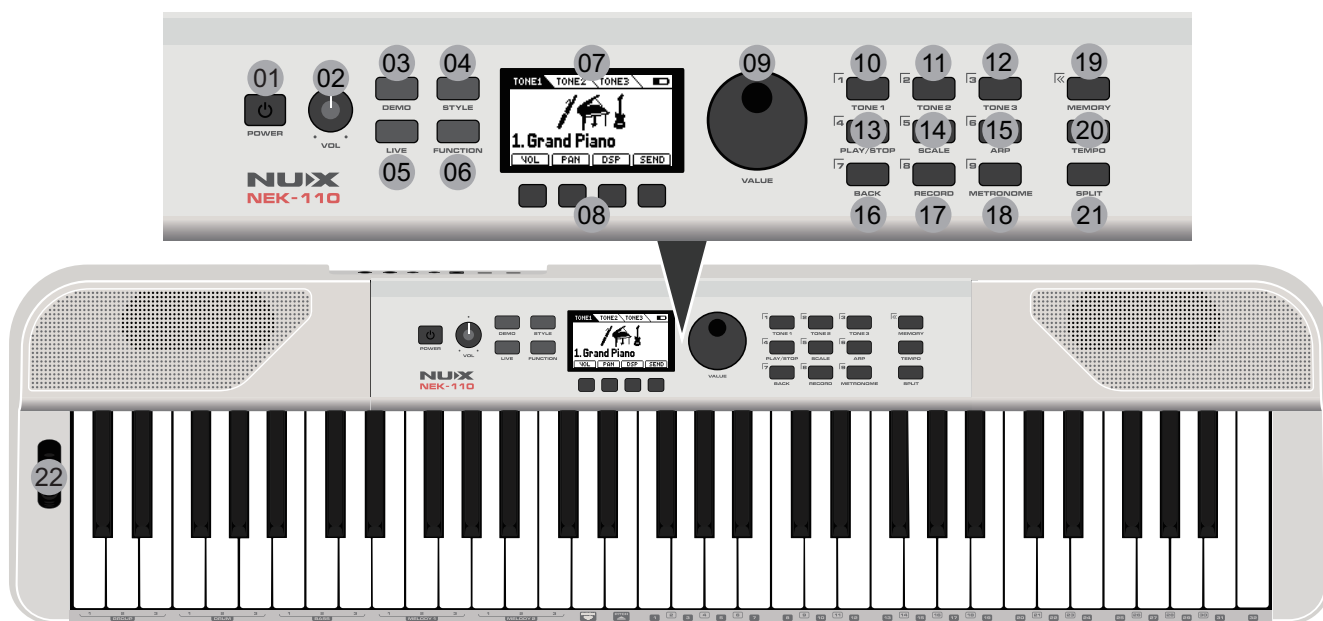

Control Panels

Front Panel



01 POWER Button

Press to turn Power On/Off.

02 VOLUME Controls

Adjust dial to increase or decrease the master volume (0-10).

03 DEMO Button

Open the demo songs menu.

04 STYLE Button

Open the Auto Accompaniment.

05 LIVE Button

Open the LIVE Music menu.

06 FUNCTION Button

Press to access function settings
Functions include: Touch Response, Effect, Bluetooth, Octave adjustment, Transpose, USB Audio, A4 tuning, DUO Mode, Reset, and INFO.

07 Display Screen

08 COMMON Buttons

Operations are assigned to these buttons according to the labels shown in the screen above the buttons.

09 Value Dial

Rotate to browse pages, set parameters or select voices / songs / styles etc.

10 TONE 1 Button

Select and play a sound.

11 TONE 2 Button

Select and play a Layered Sounds.

12 TONE 3 Button

Select and play a Layered Sounds.

13 PLAY/STOP Button

Press to start or stop the playing.

14 SCALE Button

Open the scale function.

15 ARP Button

Open the arpeggiator function.

16 BACK Button

Press to return to the previous page or exit the current settings.

17 RECORD Button

Open the Recording.

18 METRONOME Button

Press to enter and adjust metronome settings.

19 MEMORY Button

Used to save or recall user presets.

20 TEMPO Button

Adjust the tempo for the style, metronome, demo songs, and live music songs.

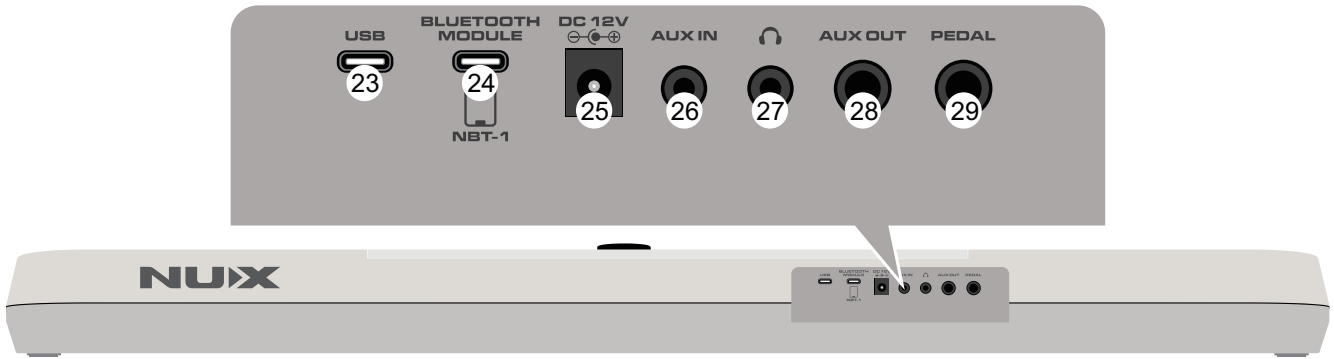
21 SPLIT Button

Split the keyboard into two sub-keyboards.

22 Pitch Bend Wheel

Rotate to smoothly slide the pitch of notes (± 2 semitones)

Rear Panel



23 USB Jack

Connect the keyboard to a computer via the USB Audio and USB MIDI jack to use it as a MIDI device.

24 BLUETOOTH MODULE Jack

Connect to NUX NBT-1 module to enable Bluetooth Audio and MIDI functions.

25 DC 12V Jack

Connect the 12V DC power adaptor (2A, center positive).

26 AUX IN JACK

3.5mm stereo Aux In jack. Connect to an external device (MP3/phone/ pad etc.) to play audio.

27 PHONES Jack

Connect a pair of headphones to this 3.5mm stereo jack.

Notes: When connected, the built-in speakers will be muted, while the AUX OUT will still work.

28 AUX OUT Jack

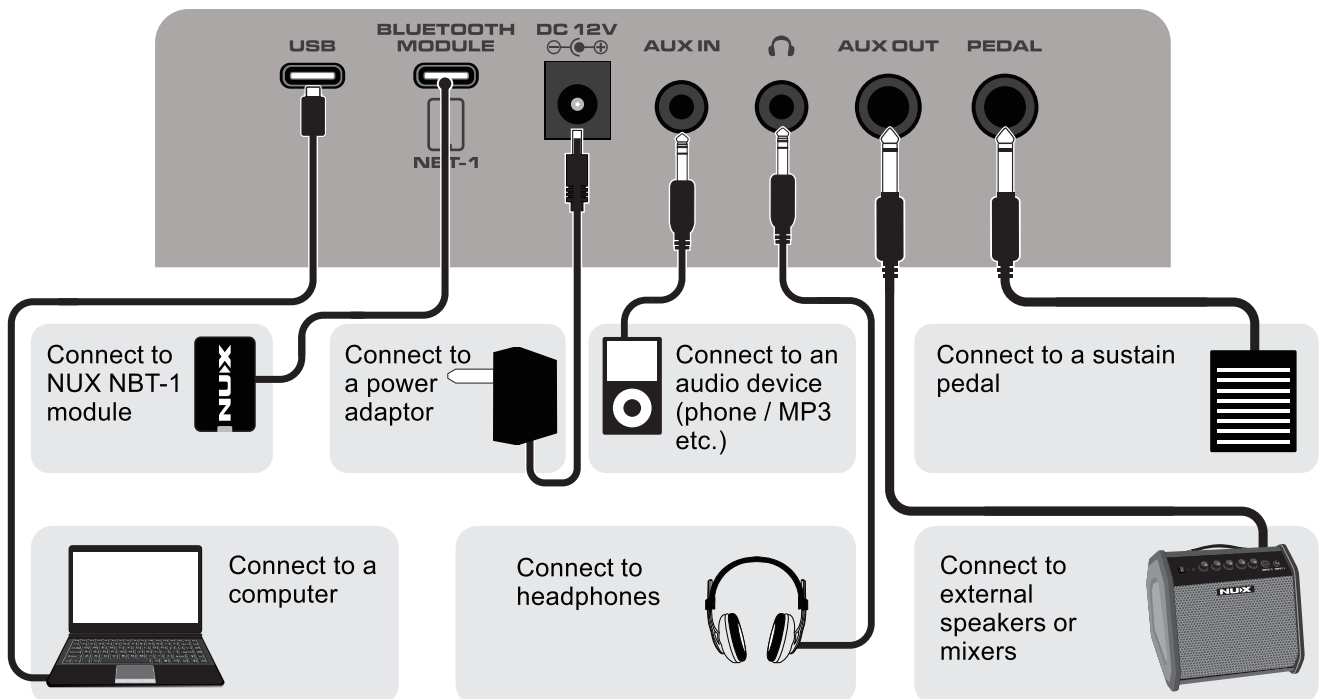
6.35mm stereo audio output jack. Use an audio cable to send the audio signal to external speakers, mixers, etc.

Notes: When connected, the built-in speakers will still work. If you'd like to mute the built-in speakers, connect a plug to the PHONES jack at the same time.

29 PEDAL Jack

Connect a sustain pedal to this jack.

Basic Connections

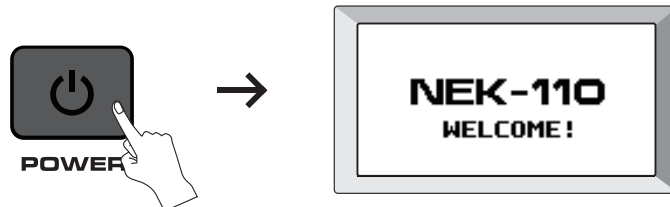


Playing the Keyboard

Turning On/Off



Use the built-in rechargeable battery or connect the included power adaptor to the DC 12V jack on the rear panel and plug it to a power supply, the NEK-110 will be ready to be powered on.



Press and hold the POWER button for 2 seconds, the NEK-110 will power on. After a welcome page, the screen will display the main page.

Press and hold the POWER button for 2 seconds, the NEK-110 will power off.

When not connected to a power supply, the NEK-110 will automatically power off after 30 minutes of inactivity.

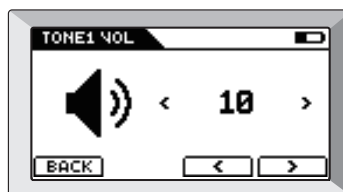
Selecting a Sound



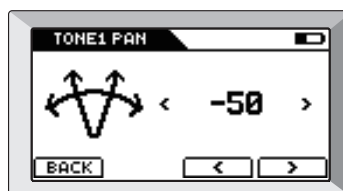
The current Sound is displayed on the main page. By default, this is set to Grand Piano.

Use the dial to select a different Sound. There are 700 great Sounds for you to select. (See the Sound List in Appendix for details.)

Tone Volume (VOL) and Pan (PAN)

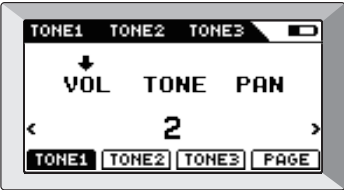


Press the **VOL** Common Button on the main page. Use the < or > Common Button or the dial to increase or decrease the current volume (0–10).



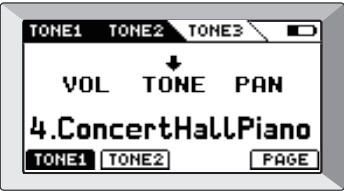
Press the **PAN** Common Button on the main page. Use the < or > Common Button or the dial to adjust the left-right audio position for the current sound. The range is -10 to 10.

Layering 2 or 3 Tones

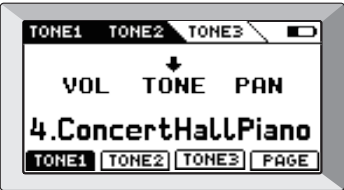


NEK-110 supports layering 2 or 3 tones. Press the **TONE 1**, **TONE 2**, and **TONE 3** buttons to combine up to three sounds. Use the Common Button below the screen to select a tone from the layered combination for adjustment.

Press the **PAGE** Common Button to switch between **VOL** (volume), **TONE** (sound selection), and **PAN** (panning) settings on the screen.



Press the **TONE 1** and **TONE 2** Button together to enter the dual tones page.



Press the **TONE 1**, **TONE 2** and **TONE 3** Button together to enter triple tones page.

Supported Combinations:

! Note: Select the corresponding buttons for each layered combination to switch between them. To switch back to a single tone, simply press any one of the **TONE 1**, **TONE 2**, or **TONE 3** buttons.

Effect Functions

DSP and **SEND** provide different effects processing for **TONE 1**, **TONE 2** and **TONE 3**.



DSP is dedicated to the insert effects processing for **TONE 1**, while **SEND** handles global effects processing for **TONE 1**, **TONE 2** and **TONE 3**.

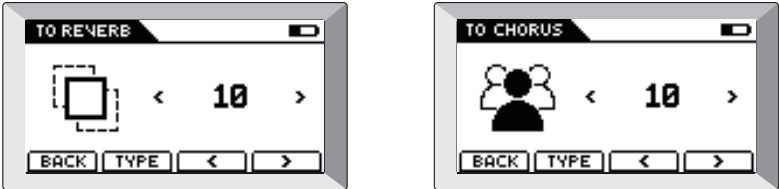
● DSP



Press the **DSP** Common Button on the main page. Use the **<** or **>** Common Button or the dial to select an effect. Press the **ON/OFF** Common Button to activate / deactivate the effect. DSP supports 36 different effect types (See the list below for detail):

● SEND



Press the **SEND** Common Button on the main page. Use the **TYPE** Common Button to select the effect. You can adjust the send level for Reverb or Chorus using the **<** or **>** Common Button or the dial.

! Note: The SEND function only controls the send level for the select tones, but does not adjust the settings of the effects themselves.

For detailed effect adjustments, refer to the “Functions & Settings – **EFFECT**”.

■ Playing a Split Tone

Press the **SPLIT** Button to split the keyboard into two sub-keyboards, so you can assign different sounds to the left-hand and right-hand area.

Press the **SPLIT** Button to activate / deactivate the keyboard into two sub-keyboards.

Hold the **SPLIT** Button to enter the split page for more detailed settings.

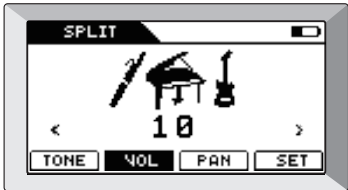


Hold the **SPLIT** Button or press **SET** Common Button to enter the split settings page.

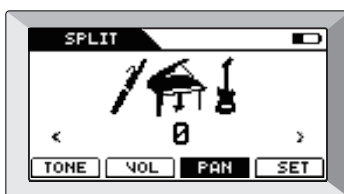
Then, use the Common Button below the screen to enter **TONE**, **VOL**, **PAN** and **SET** settings. Use the dial to adjust each parameter.

! Note: This page is dedicated to the left-hand keyboard and supports only a single tone.

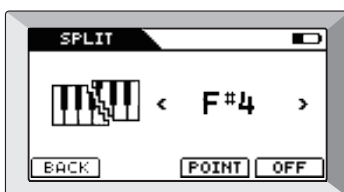
Press the **TONE** Common Button and use the dial to select a tone from 700 available options.



Press the **VOL** Common Button and use the dial to adjust the volume balance for the split keyboard (0 to 10).



Press the **PAN** Common Button and use the dial to set the left-right audio position for the split tone (-10 to 10).



The default Split Point is F#4, and you can use the dial or directly press the key to change it after selecting the **POINT** Common Button.

The sound you were playing before splitting the keyboard becomes the sound for the right-hand area, while you can select and play another sound on the right-hand area.

Press the **ON/OFF** Common Button to quickly activate / deactivate the SPLIT Mode.

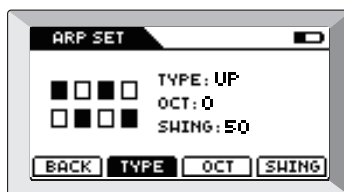
■ Adding Arpeggio



Press the **ARP** button to enter the arpeggiator settings page.

Press the **ON/OFF** Common Button to activate / deactivate the arpeggiator function.

And press **LATCH** Common Button to activate the ARP LATCH function.



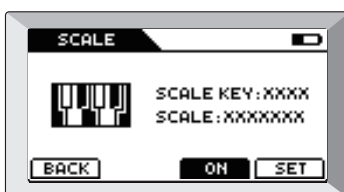
Press the **SET** Common Button to enter the ARP settings page.

Press the **TYPE** Common Button and use the dial to select the arpeggiator mode.

Press the **OCT** Common Button and use the dial to set the arpeggiator's octave range (0–2).

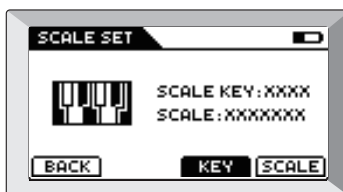
Press the **SWING** Common Button and use the dial to adjust the swing ratio of the arpeggiator rhythm (50–75).

■ Changing the Keyboard Scale



Press the **SCALE** button, then press **ON/OFF** Common Button to activate / deactivate the Smart Scale function.

Press the **SET** Common Button to adjust the scale KEY and the TYPE.



Press the **KEY** Common Button and use the dial to set the desired pitch.
 Press the **SCALE** Common Button and use the dial to choose the scale type.

User Memory Presets



Press the **MEMORY** button to display the memory settings, where you can save or recall a Bank Group. There are 9 Bank Groups available, labeled 1-9, allowing you to store all parameters, such as sound, rhythm, etc.
 Press **SAVE** Common Button to save all the parameters in the current slot. Press **LOAD** Common Button to recall them again whenever you need it.

Note: The Memory function stores only parameters related to tones, such as Split, Duo Mode, Scale, Arp, and all effect settings.

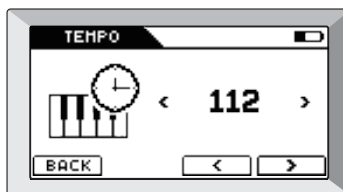
Using the Metronome



Press the **METRONOME** button to display the metronome settings, then press the Common Buttons below the screen to enter BPM, BEAT, VOICE, and VOL setting. Use the dial to adjust:

BPM	40~240
BEAT	1~9
VOICE	Bell (cow bell), Voice (human voice), 330 (mechanical sound from the classic Cherub WSM-330 metronome), Electr. (electronic sound)
VOL	0-10 Adjust the volume of the metronome.

Adjusting the Tempo



Press **TEMPO** button to display the current tempo setting, then use the dial to adjust the tempo (40-240 BPM).

■ Recording Your Playing



Press the **RECORD** button to enter the recording settings, where you can select a track and begin recording.

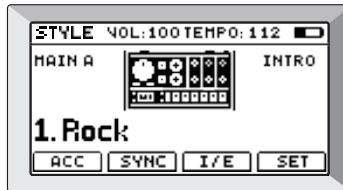
Press the **■** Common Button to start recording. Press it again to stop recording and save the track.

Press the **▶** Common Button to play back the recording. Press it again to pause playback.

Press the **MET.** Common Button to activate/deactivate the metronome. When activated, the recording will start automatically with the metronome.

Styles & Accompaniment

Playing a Style

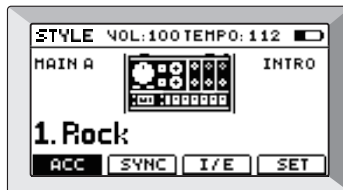


From the main page, press the **STYLE** button to enter the Rhythm / Style mode, then press the Common Buttons below the screen to enter ACC, SYNC, I/E, and SET.

Use the dial to change between the 100 rhythms / styles. (See the Style List in Appendix for details.)

Press the **PLAY/STOP** button to start / stop playing the rhythm / style.

Auto Chord (ACC)

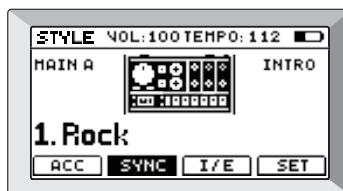


From the STYLE page, press the left Common Button labeled **ACC** to activate/deactivate Auto Chord. When activated, the keyboard will be split at F#3 and the left-hand area will be used for playing chord.

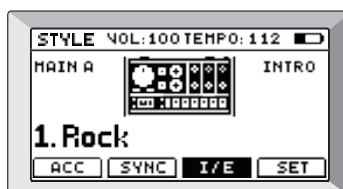

Sync Start (SYNC)



From the STYLE page, press the second Common Button labeled **SYNC** to activate/deactivate Sync Start for Auto Accompaniment. When activated, the Auto Accompaniment will start simultaneously with the first chord played on the left-hand area.

Inserting an Intro or and Ending (I/E)

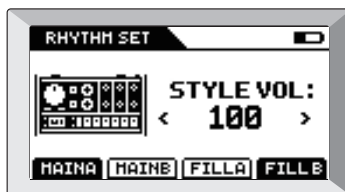


While in the Style mode, press the **I/E** Common Button to insert an Intro to the current style. When the style is played, it will start with the Intro and then move to the Main section when the Intro is finished.

Press the **I/E** Common Button again and the section will switch to the Ending. When the Ending is finished, the style will stop.

■ Changing the A/B Variations

From the STYLE page, press the **SET** Common Button to enter the main and fill modes.

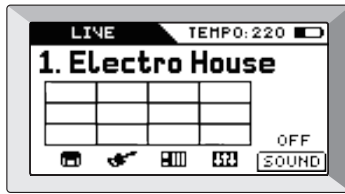


Each style has 2 variations, Main/Fill A and Main/Fill B.

In Rhythm mode, press one of the four Common Buttons below to switch between these variations. A Fill-in will be automatically added before changing.

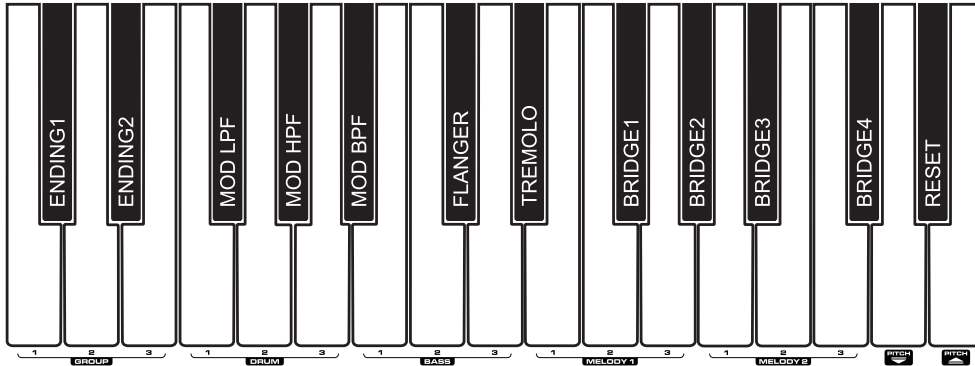
Live Music Mode

Entering the Live Music Mode

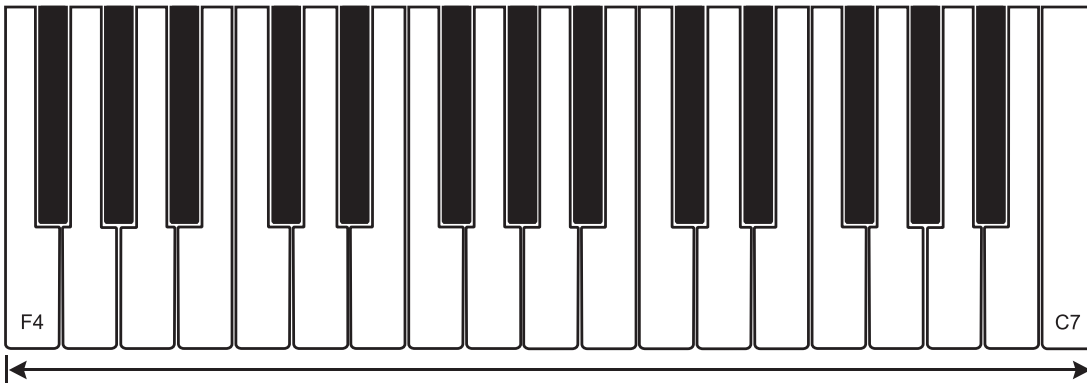


Press the button labeled **LIVE** to enter Live Music mode. The keyboard will be split at E4.

The functions of the keys on the left-hand area will be as below:



The right-hand area can be switched between the normal melody keyboard and the Live Music Sound keyboard:



Playing a Live Music

Use the dial to select one of 40 live music songs. (See the Live Music List in Appendix for details.)

Each song consists of 4 parts, DRUM, BASS, MELODY 1, and MELODY 2. For each part, there are 3 different phrases option with increasing density (1 has least density while 3 has the most density). Press the key to start/stop playing the phrase accordingly.

You can play the same option of the 4 parts together by pressing the keys in the GROUP.

Or, you can combine different option of each part. E.g. while GROUP 1 is playing as described above, pressing DRUM 2 key (G2) will change the phrase of the DRUM from DRUM 1 to DRUM 2 while the other parts stay the same.

Adjusting the Pitch

Pressing the PITCH DOWN (D4) / PITCH UP (E4) keys will adjust the overall pitch in semitones steps (-6 to 0 to +6), while the live music is playing.

Bridge, Ending, or Return to Beginning

Press the BRIDGE 1 (F#3) / BRIDGE 2 (G#3) / BRIDGE 3 (A#3) / BRIDGE 4 (C#4) key will insert a bridge with various effects. There are 4 bridge options for each live music song.

Press the ENDING 1 (C#2) / ENDING 2 (D#2) key will end the current live music song. ENDING 1 adds effects and builds up intensity, while ENDING 2 fades out.

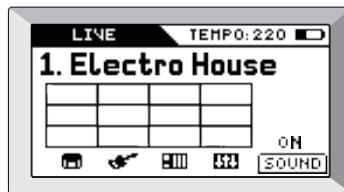
Press the RESET (D#4) key will return to the beginning of the live music song.

Using Effects

Pressing down an Effect key will apply the corresponding effect to the enter live music song. The effect name will also appear on the display screen. The effect will stop when the key is released.

Key	Effect
MOD LPF (F#2)	Modulation Low Pass Filter. Applies effect of the LPF periodically through the song.
MOD HPF (G#2)	Modulation High Pass Filter. Applies effect of the HPF periodically through the song.
MOD BPF (A#2)	Modulation Band Pass Filter. Uses the frequency band filter to achieve an effect similar to radio playback.
FLANGER (C#3)	Applies an undulating, swooshing effect to the sound.
TREMOLO (D#3)	Periodic volume changes in stereo outputs to achieve a pulsating effect.

Using Live Music Sounds



From the Live Music mode, press the Common Button which indicates the **SOUND** to switch between the normal melody keyboard and the Live Music Sound keyboard for the right-hand area(F4-C7).

When the SOUND is OFF, this enables the normal keyboard for you to play a melody along with the live music. When it's ON, it enables the live music sounds.

Demo Songs

Normal Mode

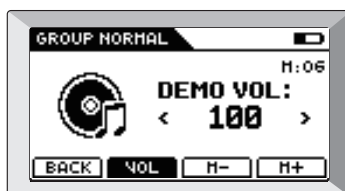


From the main page, press the **DEMO** button to enter Demo Song mode.

Use the dial to browse and select one of the demo songs.

Press the **PLAY/STOP** button to start or stop playback of the selected song.

Normal Mode Settings



Press the **SET** Common Button to enter the Normal settings. Use the dial to adjust the demo song volume.

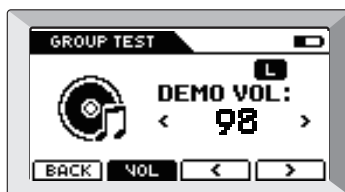
Press **M-** or **M+** Common Button to rewind or fast-forward through measures.

TEST Mode



Press the **TEST** Common Button to activate the left-hand or right-hand practice mode.

TEST Mode Settings



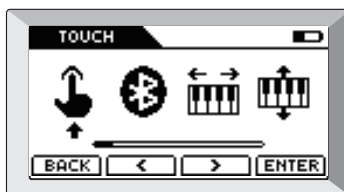
Press the **SET** Common Button to enter the TEST settings. Use the dial to adjust the volume for the left-hand or right-hand part of the demo song.

Press the **<** or **>** Common Button to switch between left-hand or right-hand playback.

! Note: There are a total of 100 Demo songs. The Normal mode uses Demo songs 1-80, while the TEST mode uses Demo songs 81-100. (See the Demo Song List in the Appendix for details.)

Functions & Settings

Press the **FUNCTION** button to display the Settings page.

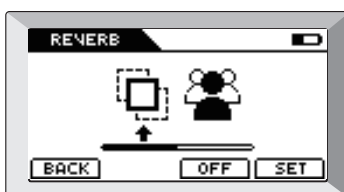


Touch Response



From the Functions page, ENTER the [👆] settings to adjust the Touch Response of the keyboard (Light1, Light2, Normal, Hard1, Hard2)

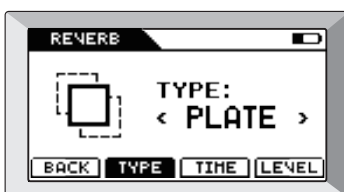
Global Effects (EFFECT)



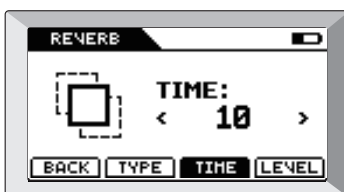
From the Functions page, ENTER the [🔊] settings to adjust the Effects. Two types are available: Reverb and Chorus.

Press the **ON/OFF** Common Button to activate/deactivate the selected effect.

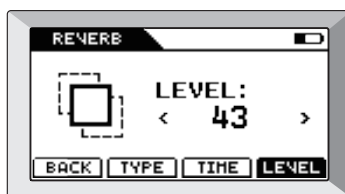
● REVERB



From the Effect page, select the REVERB effect. Press the **SET** Common Button to enter the reverb type selection page, and use the dial to select between 3 types of Reverb, including ROOM, HALL, and PLATE.



Press the **TIME** Common Button to adjust the reverb time. Use the dial to set the TIME of the Reverb (0-100).

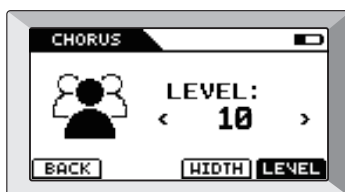


Press the **LEVEL** Common Button to adjust the reverb level. Use the dial to adjust the LEVEL of the Reverb (0-100).

● CHORUS



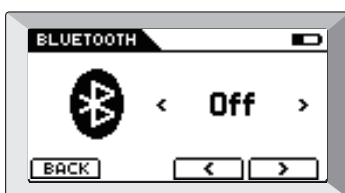
From the Effect page, select the CHORUS effect. Press the **SET** Common Button to enter the chorus settings. Use the dial to adjust the WIDTH of the CHORUS (0-100).



Press the **LEVEL** Common Button to adjust the chorus level. Use the dial to adjust the LEVEL of the CHORUS (0-100).

Note: This section explains the settings for global effects. If you need to adjust effects for specific tones (TONE 1, TONE 2, TONE 3), you can use the SEND function to adjust the send levels. And TONE 1 can apply its own standalone DSP effects. For detailed effect adjustments, refer to the “Playing the Keyboard – **Effect Functions**”.

Bluetooth Audio & MIDI



From the Functions page, ENTER the [] settings to turn ON/OFF the NBT-1 Bluetooth Module which will activate/deactivate the Bluetooth Audio and Bluetooth MIDI functions.

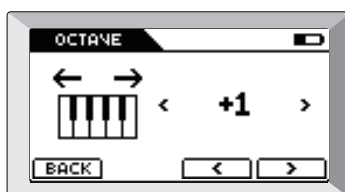
Bluetooth Audio

Open the Bluetooth list on your smart devices (phones, tablets etc.) and connect to “NEK-110”. When connected successfully, you will hear a notification sound and the blue light on the NBT-1 module will light up. Now you can stream music from your devices to the NEK-110.

Bluetooth MIDI

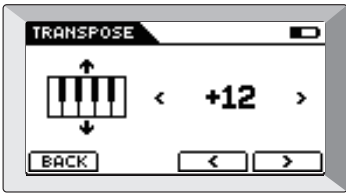
NEK-110 can be connected to various mobile APPs via Bluetooth MIDI. For example, you can connect to NUX Piano Mate and practice with the music scores in the APP. In the APP, enable Bluetooth on the music score page and connect to “NEK -110”.

Octave Shift



From the Functions page, ENTER the [] settings to overall pitch of the keyboard 1 octave up or down (-1-+1).

■Transpose



From the Functions page, ENTER the [] settings to change the overall pitch of the keyboard in semitone steps (-12-+12).

■USB AUDIO & MIDI



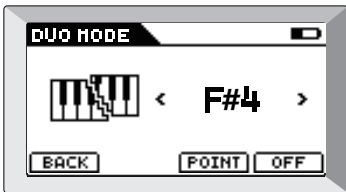
From the Functions page, ENTER the [] settings to adjust the recording level (±12).

■Overall Pitch (A4)



From the Functions page, ENTER the [] settings to adjust the A4 (420-460Hz).

■Duo Mode



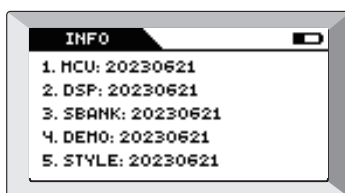
From the Functions page, ENTER the [] settings to split the keyboard into two sub-keyboards. The default Split Point is F#4, and you can use the dial or directly press the key to change it after selecting the POINT Common Button. Press the ON/OFF Common Button to activate / deactivate the DUO Mode.

■Factory Reset



From the Functions page, ENTER the [↺] settings to do factory reset. Once confirmed, all your personal edits or user presets will be cleared.

■ System Info



From the Functions page, ENTER the [ⓘ] settings to check the system information.
